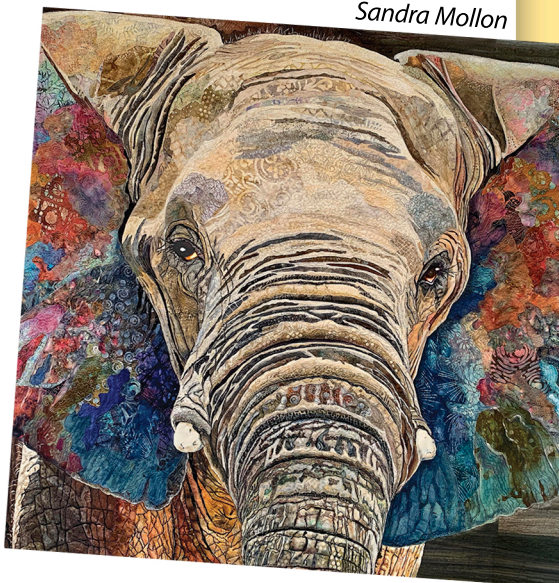

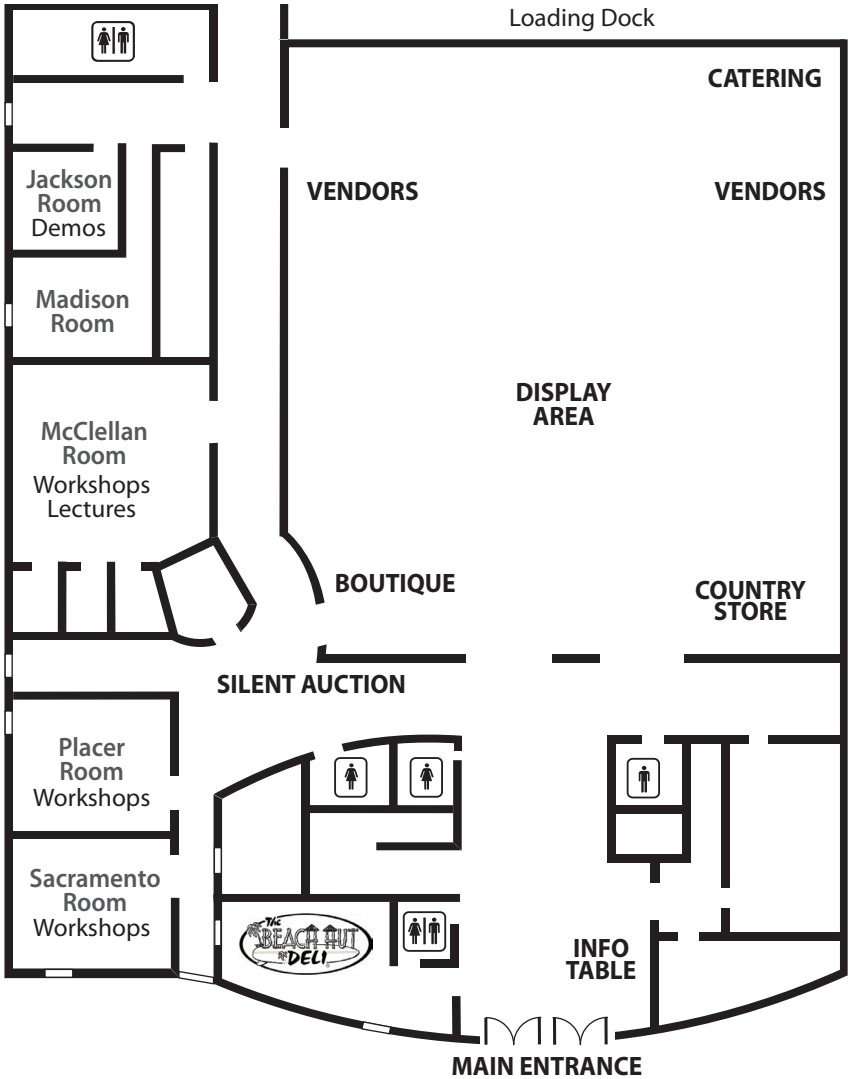

Our featured artist, Sandra Mollon, is an award winning quilter who has shown her work at international and regional juried shows. Sandra and her quilting partner, Kris Spray, won a major purchase award at the 2019 Spring Paducah Quilt Show for "Seasons of Life", which means that the quilt will be in the permanent collection of the National Quilt Museum!

Other recent ribbons include: Outstanding Large Quilt, a major award at Road to California (2019); as well as a 2nd place in the Animal Category; 1st place in the Wall Quilt Category in MQX New England (2019); Honorable Mention at AQS Grand Rapids (2018); Best Use of Color Award at the Lancaster Quilt Fest (2019); 3rd place Wall Category, Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival (2018); 2nd place Wall Category, Pacific International Quilt Show (2018); 3rd place at TAG Art Gallery (2018), and Best of Show at the River City Quilters' Guild Show (2018).

This year’s Opportunity Quilt was awarded “Best Use of Color,” as well 2nd place for “Pieced Quilts, Large, Group 3+,” at the River City Quilters’ Guild Quilt Show in 2018. It was designed by Madhu Mathur of Jaipur, India. Guild members Laurel Anderson, Korey Chase, Nancy MacDonald, and Jacque Tucker selected the color palate. Mr. Chase arranged the color placement for the blocks creating a balance between the colors, prints and background fabrics. The blocks were pieced by many of our members and arranged by Laurel Anderson, Chris Shores-Hague, and Korey Chase. Long-arm quilter, Marie Nelson of Sacramento, used variegated thread colors to create an overall beautiful design on both sides. Pat Weissensee added the final touch with a flanged binding. - Judges' Choice (one per judge)
- Best of Category Awards (selected from the 1st place winners in that category)
