

The 2024 UFO Challenge

The goal of the UFO Challenge is to complete existing UFOs and prevent the addition of more UFOs in your quilting journey. Quilt projects that you started before, but did not complete as of December 31, 2023, are considered UFOs.

You have four way to earn points. Each completed UFO earns you **10 points**. Receive **10 bonus points** for completing a project that was started in or before 2012. Any quilting project started and completed within 60 days during 2024, **and reported by November 30, 2024** earns **7 points**. New quilt projects started and completed in 2024, which took longer than 60 days to complete, and reported to the UFO Challenge Chair by November 30, 2024 will receive **5 points**.

To be counted for this year's Challenge a picture of the quilt must be sent to the Challenge Chair, Linda Ruyters, at lruyters@yahoo.com. ***If the picture is not received by November 30, 2024 the project cannot be counted towards this year's Challenge.***

Begin by listing up to 20 UFOs you would like to complete during 2024 on your Challenge Log (the form has two sides). You may add projects as you wish, but please notify lruyters@yahoo.com in order that records be kept current. Submit your original Log with the \$5 fee to the Challenge Chair. I will keep the original in the file, make a copy for your records and return the copy to you via US Mail.

There is no entry deadline. You may choose to enter the Challenge at any time during the year by completing and submitting a UFO Entry Log, along with the \$5 fee.

Entry forms and logs are available at the Guild website, as well as at monthly Guild meetings. You may turn in your logs and entry fees at any Guild meeting or mail to:

Using the UFO Challenge Log you will keep track of your completed projects throughout the year. When you complete a project send a photo to lruyters@yahoo.com. Your photos will be shared with other Challenge participants and posted to the Guild's social media accounts, as time permits. You are encouraged to show your completed projects.

Prizes will be awarded to the three Challengers who accumulate the most points. Prize amounts will be determined by the amount of total amount of money collected for the Challenge.
